Description

This sterling silver wine taster, or tastevin, was crafted in London in 1975 by the esteemed silversmiths DA-MAR Silverware.

This elegant piece is a classic example of a traditional sommelier's tool, designed to assess the colour and clarity of wine.

The item bears a full set of British hallmarks, including the London assay mark, the sterling silver standard mark, the date letter for 1975, and the distinctive "DA-MAR Silverware" maker's mark. These clear marks guarantee its quality and historical authenticity.

Following traditional tastevin design, the shallow, concave cup is made of highly reflective sterling silver, a metal traditionally favoured by sommeliers for its ability to catch and reflect light, allowing for a precise evaluation of the wine's hue and any potential sediment. It features an elegant form, likely incorporating classic elements such as fluted or punched decoration, and a small, often ergonomic, handle for easy handling.

Historical Context: Crafted in the mid-1970s, this tastevin serves as both a functional item for the dedicated wine enthusiast and a handsome piece of vintage barware. It is a tangible link to a rich history of winemaking and tasting that traces its roots back to the Burgundy region of France.
