Description

This elegant Art Deco cigarette box is a superb example of mid-20th-century British silversmithing, crafted by the renowned London maker William Comyns & Sons. Fully hallmarked for London, 1947, the piece embodies the clean geometry and understated sophistication that defined the late Art Deco period.

The box features a sleek, rectilinear form with stepped side supports—classic Art Deco styling that emphasizes symmetry and refined minimalism. The smooth, mirror-polished silver exterior gives it a timeless presence, while the hinged lid opens to reveal a beautifully preserved wooden interior, designed originally to hold cigarettes but equally suited today for jewellery, desk accessories, or other small valuables.
