Description

A fine Victorian solid silver one-pint tankard, assayed in London in 1878 and made by the respected silversmith Walter John Barnard. Elegantly proportioned, the tankard features a classic cylindrical body with subtle tapering, a sturdy scroll handle, and a gently domed base, reflecting the restrained confidence of late-19th-century English silver design.

Walter John Barnard was part of the well-known Barnard family of silversmiths, whose work is admired for its quality craftsmanship and enduring practicality. This tankard embodies those values, offering both pleasing weight in the hand and timeless visual appeal.
