Description

An antique ceramic scuttle-form biscuit barrel (cookie jar), featuring a hand-painted pastoral scene with cobalt blue and gilt accents, complemented by an ornate silver-plated swing handle, hinged lid, and matching footed base.

Glazed ceramic/porcelain with silver-plated metal mountings and an insulated handle grip. Style: Scuttle shape (resembling a coal scuttle) popular in late 19th-century English tablewares by makers like Carlton Ware or Doulton Burslem. Function: Used on formal dining or tea tables to keep biscuits fresh.
