A rather wonderful Charles II Solid Silver round Counter Box with the original 12 counters inside. The Box and the counters are all gilded. The lid of the Box shows an image of cupid rising a hammer over a pair of hearts clasped in tongs held over a forge. The words above his head state DE DVS IE NEN FAIX QVVN. The counters all have a pair of flaming sacred hearts surrounded by leaves on the one side and the other side a pair of intertwined initials surrounded by leaves.
