The pap boat has a shell and gadroon border.

A silver pap boat is a small, spoon-like container made of silver, used for serving pap, a type of porridge or gruel made from maize meal. The shape of the boat allows for easy pouring of the pap onto a plate or bowl. Silver pap boats were commonly used in the 19th century and are now considered antique collectibles.
